1 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-first*  
2 *General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

3 That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, **amend** Rule  
4 No. 35 (a) as follows:

5 **35. Reconsideration**

6 (a) After a question has been decided by the House, any member  
7 recorded as having voted on the prevailing side may, at any time  
8 before adjournment of the current legislative day, move to  
9 reconsider or may give notice of intention to move to reconsider.  
10 Notice having been given, such member may move to reconsider  
11 on the same day or before 12 o'clock noon of the next day of  
12 actual session, but after the adoption of a resolution fixing the time  
13 for adjournment sine die, any member may so move. A MEMBER
