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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-716, **amend**  
3 (7) (a) as follows:

4           **24-33.5-716. Interoperable communications among public**  
5 **safety radio systems - statewide plan - regional plans - governmental**  
6 **immunity - needs assessment - definitions - repeal.** (7) (a) The  
7 executive director, in consultation with the public safety communications  
8 subcommittee created in section 24-33.5-1614 (3.3), shall perform a  
9 needs assessment and create a business plan regarding statewide radio  
10 communications. The executive director shall submit a report regarding  
11 the findings and conclusions of the needs assessment and business plan  
12 to the joint budget committee on or before ~~December 31, 2014~~ JUNE 30,  
13 2015.

14           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
