Concerning the enactment of Colorado Revised Statutes 2015 as the positive and statutory law of the state of Colorado.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-5-126, **add** (2) (s) as follows:

2-5-126. Annual enactment of Colorado Revised Statutes - validation - effective date. (2) The annual statutes, copies of which shall be delivered to each member of the general assembly, together with a listing of the revisor's changes, constitute the official report of the committee on legal services and are hereby enacted in accordance with this section as follows:

(s) **Colorado Revised Statutes 2015.** Colorado Revised Statutes 2015, which consists of all of the laws of the state of Colorado of a general and permanent nature originally enacted in "Colorado Revised Statutes 1973", including subsequent
