A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION TO RENEW A STATE-ISSUED**
102 **IDENTIFICATION CARD BY ELECTRONIC MEANS, AND, IN**
103 **CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

The bill authorizes a person over 65 years of age to electronically renew an identification card issued by the department of revenue.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-304, **amend**
3 **(1.7) (a) (II); and add (1.8) as follows:**

4 **42-2-304. Validity of identification card - rules.** (1.7) (a) If
5 allowed under federal law, the department shall allow renewal of an
6 identification card issued under section 42-2-302 by mail subject to the
7 following requirements:

8 (II) Renewal by mail shall IS only be available every other renewal
9 period; EXCEPT THAT RENEWAL BY MAIL IS AVAILABLE EVERY RENEWAL
10 PERIOD IF THE APPLICANT IS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

11 (1.8) (a) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT TO
12 RENEW AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER SECTION 42-2-302 BY
13 ELECTRONIC MEANS IF THE APPLICANT:

14 (I) IS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER;

15 (II) ATTESTS UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY TO BEING LAWFULLY
16 PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES;

17 (III) ATTESTS UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY TO BEING A RESIDENT
18 OF COLORADO; AND

19 (IV) PAYS ANY REQUIRED FEE OR SURCHARGE.

20 (b) APPLICANTS WHO MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF PARAGRAPH
21 (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1) MAY ELECTRONICALLY RENEW EVERY
22 RENEWAL PERIOD.

23 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
24 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
25 licensing services cash fund created in section 42-2-114.5, Colorado
26 Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of
27 revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$4,588, or

1 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allocated to the information
2 technology division for the implementation of this act.

3 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
4 appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
5 budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$4,588,
6 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of
7 information technology, for the provision of computer center services for
8 the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said
9 sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of
10 revenue out of the appropriation made subsection (1) of this section.

11 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
12 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
13 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
14 general assembly (August 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8,
15 2013); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
16 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
17 or part of this act within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of
18 the general assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
19 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
20 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
21 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

22 (2) This act applies to identification card renewals on or after
23 January 1, 2014.
