A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPEAL DATE OF THE COLORADO COMMISSION ON CRIMINAL AND JUVENILE <u>JUSTICE</u>, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

The bill eliminates the repeal date of the Colorado commission on criminal and juvenile justice.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 16-11.3-105
3	as follows:
4	16-11.3-105. Repeal of article. This article is repealed, effective
5	July 1, 2013.
6	SECTION 2. Appropriation. In addition to any other
7	appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
8	general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of public
9	safety, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$255,443 and
10	2.5 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the
11	division of criminal justice for staff and other support for the Colorado
12	commission on criminal and juvenile justice related to the implementation
13	of this act.
14	SECTION <u>3.</u> Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
15	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
16	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
