A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE REPEAL DATE OF THE COLORADO COMMISSION ON**
102 **CRIMINAL AND JUVENILE JUSTICE, AND, IN CONNECTION**
103 **THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 16-11.3-105
3 as follows:

4 **16-11.3-105. Repeal of article.** This article is repealed effective
5 ~~July 1, 2013~~ JULY 1, 2018.

6 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-11.3-103, **amend**
7 (5) as follows:

8 **16-11.3-103. Duties of the commission - mission - staffing -**
9 **repeal.** (5) (a) The division of criminal justice in the department of
10 public safety, in consultation with the department of corrections, shall
11 provide resources for data collection, research, analysis, and publication
12 of the commission's findings and reports.

13 (b) UPON THE REQUEST OF THE COMMISSION, THE OFFICE OF
14 LEGISLATIVE LEGAL SERVICES CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-3-501,
15 C.R.S., SHALL PROVIDE A STAFF MEMBER TO ATTEND MEETINGS OF THE
16 COMMISSION.

17 **SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
18 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
19 general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of public
20 safety, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$255,443 and
21 2.5 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the
22 division of criminal justice for staff and other support for the Colorado
23 commission on criminal and juvenile justice related to the implementation
24 of this act.

25 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
26 appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise
27 appropriated, to the department of corrections, for the fiscal year

1 beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$56,160, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, for allocation to the executive director's office, for support
3 of the Colorado commission on criminal and juvenile justice related to the
4 implementation of this act.

5 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
6 appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise
7 appropriated, to the legislative department, for the fiscal year beginning
8 July 1, 2013, the sum of \$6,061 and 0.1 FTE, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, for allocation to the committee on legal services, for support
10 of the Colorado commission on criminal and juvenile justice related to the
11 implementation of this act.

12 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
