101	CONCERNING CATALYTIC CONVERTERS, AND, IN CONNECTION
102	THEREWITH, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE EVALUATION
103	AND CERTIFICATION OF AFTERMARKET CATALYTIC
104	CONVERTERS AND ENACTING MEASURES TO ADDRESS THE THEFT
105	OF CATALYTIC CONVERTERS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

Section 1 of the bill requires the air quality control commission in the department of public health and environment to promulgate rules

establishing:

- Evaluation procedures for aftermarket catalytic converters; and
- Procedures for the division of administration in the department of public health and environment (division) to use to certify aftermarket catalytic converters for installation and sale.

Section 2 states that on and after October 31, 2022, it is unlawful to install, sell, offer for sale, or advertise any used, recycled, or salvaged catalytic converter unless the catalytic converter is an aftermarket catalytic converter that has been certified for installation and sale by the division.

For the purposes of regulating purchases of commodity metals and the commodities metals theft task force, **section 3** amends the definition of "commodity metal" to include rhodium, palladium, or platinum-clad components of a catalytic converter. For the purposes of the existing criminal statute prohibiting the operation of motor vehicle chop shops, **section 4** adds catalytic converters to the definition of "major component motor vehicle part". **Section 5** requires each auto parts recycler to consult the national motor vehicle title information system for each catalytic converter that the auto parts recycler acquires from the recycling of a motor vehicle in order to determine whether the catalytic converter is stolen.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

13	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 42-4-243 as
14	follows:

17	(2) OF THIS SECTION, ON AND AFTER OCTOBER 31, 2022, IT IS UNLAWFUL
18	FOR A PERSON TO INSTALL, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR ADVERTISE ANY
19	USED, RECYCLED, OR SALVAGED CATALYTIC CONVERTER.
20	(2) A PERSON MAY INSTALL, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR ADVERTISE
21	AN AFTERMARKET CATALYTIC CONVERTER, AS DEFINED IN SECTION
22	25-7-143 (1)(a), IF THE AFTERMARKET CATALYTIC CONVERTER HAS BEEN

10	SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-4-420, amend
11	(5)(b)(XV) and (5)(b)(XVI); and add (5)(b)(XVII) as follows:
12	18-4-420. Chop shop activity - ownership or operation of a
13	chop shop - altered or removed identification number - penalties -
14	definitions. (5) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise
15	requires:
16	(b) "Major component motor vehicle part" means any of the
17	following parts of a motor vehicle:
18	(XV) A wheel or tire; or
19	(XVI) Any other part of a motor vehicle that is comparable in
20	design or function to any of the parts that have been listed, or that have
21	been labeled with a unique traceable identification number, by the
22	manufacturer of the motor vehicle or part. A CATALYTIC CONVERTER; OR
23	(XVII) ANY OTHER PART OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS
24	COMPARABLE IN DESIGN OR FUNCTION TO ANY OF THE PARTS THAT HAVE
25	BEEN LISTED, OR THAT HAVE BEEN LABELED WITH A UNIQUE TRACEABLE
26	IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, BY THE MANUFACTURER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE
27	OR PART.

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1	SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 42-4-2205 as
2	follows:
3	42-4-2205. Catalytic converters - checks for stolen materials
4	required. For each catalytic converter that an auto parts
5	RECYCLER ACQUIRES FROM THE RECYCLING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, THE
6	AUTO PARTS RECYCLER SHALL CONSULT THE NATIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE
7	TITLE INFORMATION SYSTEM TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE CATALYTIC
8	CONVERTER IS STOLEN.
9	SECTION 6. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
