Bill Summary

SENATE 3rd Reading Unamended April 12, 2018

SENATE Amended 2nd Reading April 11, 2018 repeals on September 1, 2018. The bill extends the title 12 recodification study for one additional year, through September 1, 2019.

14	SECTION 2. Appropriation. (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
15	year, \$54,257 is appropriated to the legislative department for use by the
16	committee on legal services. This appropriation is from the general fund.
17	The committee may use this appropriation as follows:
18	(a) \$53,307 for personal services, which amount is based on the
19	assumption that the committee will require an additional 1.0 FTE; and
20	(b) \$950 for operating expenses.
21	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
22	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
23	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
24	8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
