## A BILL FOR AN ACT

### 101 CONCERNING PROHIBITING JUVENILE FACILITIES FROM PROVIDING

102 CARE FOR A JUVENILE WHO IS TRUANT.

### **Bill Summary**

The bill prohibits a juvenile detention facility from receiving or providing care for a juvenile who violates a court order to attend school unless the juvenile is also adjudicated for a delinquent act and remains under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court for committing the delinquent act.

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 19-2-402, add (1) (c)
3 as follows:

4 19-2-402. Juvenile detention services and facilities to be 5 provided by department of human services - education. (1) (c) A 6 DETENTION FACILITY OPERATED BY OR UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE 7 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES SHALL NOT RECEIVE OR PROVIDE CARE 8 FOR A JUVENILE WHO VIOLATES A COURT ORDER TO ATTEND SCHOOL AS 9 REQUIRED UNDER THE "SCHOOL ATTENDANCE LAW OF 1963", ARTICLE 33 10 OF TITLE 22, C.R.S., UNLESS THE JUVENILE IS ALSO FOUND GUILTY OF AND 11 ADJUDICATED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE FOR COMMITTING A 12 DELINQUENT ACT AND REMAINS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE 13 JUVENILE COURT FOR COMMITTING THE DELINQUENT ACT.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
