Bill Summary

Under current law, an owner of special mobile machinery may

obtain from the department of revenue a registration exempt certificate for the special mobile machinery only if the owner regularly has 1,000 or more items of special mobile machinery in the state. The bill allows an owner of any amount of special mobile machinery located in the state to obtain a registration exempt certificate for the special mobile machinery.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-107, amend 3 (16)(g)(I)(A) as follows: 4 42-3-107. Taxable value of classes of property - rate of tax -5 when and where payable - department duties - apportionment of tax 6 collections - definitions - rules - repeal. (16) (g) (I) An owner of special 7 mobile machinery who pays specific ownership taxes in accordance with 8 this subsection (16) may apply to the department for a registration exempt 9 certificate, which the department shall issue to the owner if: 10 (A) The department verifies that the owner regularly has one 11 thousand or more items of such AT LEAST ONE ITEM OF special mobile 12 machinery in the state; 13 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 16 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 17 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 18 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 19 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 20 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 21 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
