Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The "State Measurement For Accountable, Responsive, and Transparent (SMART) Government Act" (SMART Act) establishes a performance management system to better allow the public, the general

assembly, the governor, and state departments to assess, manage, and improve the administration and performance of state programs. The bill adds the office of saving people money on health care, created within the governor's office by executive order, to the list of departments that are required to comply with the requirements of the SMART Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-7-202, amend 3 (5)(a); and **add** (11.5) as follows: 4 **2-7-202. Definitions.** As used in this part 2, unless the context 5 otherwise requires: 6 (5) (a) "Department" means the judicial department, the office of 7 state public defender, the office of alternate defense counsel, the office 8 of the child's representative, the office of the child protection 9 ombudsman, the public employees' retirement association, the Colorado 10 energy office, the office of economic development, THE OFFICE OF SAVING 11 PEOPLE MONEY ON HEALTH CARE, and the principal departments of the 12 executive branch of state government as specified in section 24-1-110, 13 C.R.S., including any division, office, agency, or other unit created within 14 a principal department. 15 (11.5) "Office of saving people money on health care" 16 MEANS THE OFFICE OF SAVING PEOPLE MONEY ON HEALTH CARE, CREATED 17 WITHIN THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE BY EXECUTIVE ORDER B 2019 003. 18 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-7-204, amend 19 (1)(c), (3)(a)(I), and (3)(b) as follows: 20 **2-7-204.** Performance management systems. (1) (c) No later 21 than August 1, 2013, and no later than August 1 of each year thereafter, 22 the department of state, the department of the treasury, the department of 23 law, the office of state public defender, the office of alternate defense

counsel, the Colorado energy office, the office of economic development, the office of the child's representative, and the office of the child protection ombudsman, AND THE OFFICE OF SAVING PEOPLE MONEY ON HEALTH CARE shall each publish their components of the performance management systems for their respective department, office, or commission. These instructions must be posted on the official websites administered by the respective departments, offices, and commissions.

(3) (a) (I) Except as provided in subparagraphs (II) and (III) of this paragraph (a) SUBSECTIONS (3)(a)(II) AND (3)(a)(III) OF THIS SECTION, no later than July 1, 2014, and no later than July 1 of each year thereafter, each department shall develop a performance plan in accordance with the performance management system and submit that plan to the joint budget committee and the appropriate joint committee of reference as determined pursuant to section 2-7-203. The performance plan serves as a guide to a department's major functions and as a tool to evaluate performance goals over time.

(b) Each department's performance plan shall be posted on the official websites of the department and the office of state planning and budgeting. The state treasurer, the attorney general, the secretary of state, the state court administrator for the judicial department, the office of state public defender, the office of alternate defense counsel, the public employees' retirement association, the Colorado energy office, the office of economic development, the office of the child's representative, and the office of the child protection ombudsman, AND THE OFFICE OF SAVING PEOPLE MONEY ON HEALTH CARE shall ensure the office of state planning and budgeting receives the information required to be posted on the office of state planning and budgeting's website pursuant to this paragraph (b)

(1) (a) (I) Except as 12 provided in subparagraph (II) of this paragraph (a) SUBSECTION (1)(a)(II) 13 OF THIS SECTION, no later than November 1, 2014, and no later than 14 November 1 of each year thereafter, the office of state planning and 15 budgeting shall publish an annual performance report for each department 16 except the department of state, the department of the treasury, the 17 department of law, the judicial department, the office of state public 18 defender, the office of alternate defense counsel, the Colorado energy 19 office, the office of economic development, the office of the child's 20 representative, and the office of the child protection ombudsman, AND 21 THE OFFICE OF SAVING PEOPLE MONEY ON HEALTH CARE. The annual 22 performance report must include a summary of each department's 23 performance plan and most recent performance evaluation. The annual 24 performance report must be clearly written and easily understood and 25 must be limited to a maximum of four pages per department. 26 (b) No later than November 1, 2014, and no later than November
