#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING MODIFICATION OF THE FEE FOR LATE REGISTRATION OF

102 A VEHICLE.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Effective July 1, 2013, the bill changes the fee for late registration of a vehicle from a fee of \$25 per month to a flat fee of \$20 and repeals an exemption from the late fee for a vehicle that has expired temporary registration number plates, tags, or certificates.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	<b>SECTION 1.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-112, amend (1)
3	and (1.5) (a) introductory portion; and <b>repeal</b> (1.5) (a) (III) as follows:
4	42-3-112. Failure to pay tax - penalty - rules. (1) If a vehicle
5	subject to taxation under this article is not registered when required by
6	law, the vehicle owner shall pay a late fee of twenty-five TWENTY dollars
7	for each month or portion of a month following the expiration of the
8	registration period, or, if applicable, the expiration of the grace period
9	described in section 42-3-114 for which the vehicle is unregistered
10	except that the amount of the late fee shall not exceed one hundred
11	dollars. The late fee shall be IS due when the vehicle is registered.
12	(1.5) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this
13	section, the executive director of the department shall promulgate rules
14	in accordance with article 4 of title 24, C.R.S., that establish
15	circumstances in addition to the circumstances described in subsection (3)
16	of this section in which a vehicle owner shall be IS exempted from paying
17	the late fee described in said subsection (1). The rules shall MUST apply
18	uniformly throughout the state and shall MUST include, but shall ARE not
19	be limited to, exemptions for:
20	(III) Temporary registration number plates, tags, or certificates
21	that have expired;
22	SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act takes effect
23	July 1, 2013, and applies to late fees accrued on or after said date.
24	<b>SECTION 3. Safety clause.</b> The general assembly hereby finds
25	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
26	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
