## A BILL FOR AN ACT

### 101 CONCERNING CONTINUING COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR

102 ADMINISTRATORS OF ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires an operator of an assisted living facility to ensure that the administrator of the facility completes 30 credits of continuing competency every 2 years. The operator must maintain records on the facility premises as proof of the fulfillment of the competency requirements. The department of public health and environment is required to promulgate rules concerning the competency requirements. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 25-27-104.3 as
3 follows:

4 25-27-104.3. Administrators - continuing competency - rules. 5 AN OPERATOR OF AN ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY SHALL ENSURE THAT THE 6 ADMINISTRATOR OF THE FACILITY COMPLETES THIRTY CREDITS OF 7 CONTINUING COMPETENCY EVERY TWO YEARS. THE OPERATOR SHALL 8 MAINTAIN RECORDS ON THE ASSISTED LIVING RESIDENCE PREMISES AS 9 PROOF OF FULFILLMENT OF THE COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS IN A FORM 10 AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 11 PROMULGATE RULES TO ESTABLISH THE CONTINUING COMPETENCY 12 REQUIREMENTS, WHICH MUST INCLUDE AT LEAST ONE CREDIT HOUR FOR 13 ETHICS AND AT LEAST ONE CREDIT HOUR CONCERNING EMPLOYEE 14 MANAGEMENT.

15 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 16 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 17 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 18 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a 19 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 20 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 21 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 22 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 23 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 24 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
