## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AN EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN ADDITIONAL CHARGES 102 IMPOSED AT THE TIME OF VEHICLE REGISTRATION FOR 103 VEHICLES THAT ARE THIRTY YEARS OLD OR OLDER.

## **Bill Summary**

#### Under current law:

! An additional vehicle-age-based motor vehicle registration fee is imposed at the time of registration on passenger cars and certain other types of motor vehicles that are required to be registered; and

! A road safety surcharge is imposed at the time of registration, subject to limited exceptions, on each vehicle that is required to be registered.

For registration periods commencing on or after July 1, 2018, the bill exempts any vehicle that is 30 years old or older from both the road safety surcharge and the additional vehicle-age-based motor vehicle registration fee.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-306, amend 3 (2)(b)(II) introductory portion and (2)(b)(II)(C) as follows: 4 42-3-306. Registration fees - passenger and passenger-mile 5 taxes - fee schedule - repeal. (2) Fees for the annual registration of 6 passenger-carrying motor vehicles shall be as follows: 7 (b) (II) In addition to the registration fees imposed by 8 subparagraph (I) of this paragraph (b) SUBSECTION (2)(b)(I) OF THIS 9 SECTION, an additional registration fee shall be IS imposed on the motor 10 vehicles described in the introductory portion to this paragraph (b) SUBSECTION (2)(b)(I) OF THIS SECTION, based on the age of the motor 11 12 vehicle, as follows: 13 (C) For motor vehicles ten years old or older BUT LESS THAN 14 THIRTY YEARS OLD, seven dollars. 15 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-4-804, amend 16 (1)(a)(I) introductory portion; and add (1)(a)(VI.5) as follows: 17 43-4-804. Highway safety projects - surcharges and fees -18 crediting of moneys to highway users tax fund - definition. (1) On and 19 after July 1, 2009, the following surcharges, fees, and fines shall be 20 collected and credited to the highway users tax fund created in section 21 43-4-201 (1)(a) and allocated to the state highway fund, counties, and 22 municipalities as specified in section 43-4-205 (6.3):

12	SECTION 3. Applicability. This act applies to additional
13	vehicle-age-based registration fees and road safety surcharges imposed
14	at the time of registration on vehicles registered for any registration
15	period that commences on or after July 1, 2018.
16	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
17	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
