A BILL FOR AN ACT

Bill Summary

The bill modifies the definition of "public records" under the "Colorado Open Records Act" to include all writings made, maintained, or kept by a private organization that receives moneys collected by the state or a political subdivision of the state at the request of a public employee or taxpayer and that involve the receipt or expenditure of

7	POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TRANSFERS MONEYS TO A PRIVATE ORGANIZATION
8	ON BEHALF OF A PUBLIC EMPLOYEE OR A TAXPAYER, ALL WRITINGS MADE,
9	MAINTAINED, OR KEPT BY THE PRIVATE ORGANIZATION THAT INVOLVE THE
10	RECEIPT OR EXPENDITURE OF MONEYS BY THE PRIVATE ORGANIZATION.
11	EXPENDITURE SHALL BE DEFINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY
12	ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES.
13	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
14	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
15	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
16	5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, if a
17	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
18	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
19	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
20	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
21	November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
22	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
