## **Bill Summary**

Sunset Process - Senate Health and Human Services Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department





of regulatory agencies' sunset review and report concerning the "Michael Skolnik Medical Transparency Act of 2010" to continue the act for 7 years, until 2028.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, repeal 3 (21)(a)(VI); and **add** (29)(a)(XIII) as follows: 4 24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies 5 and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative 6 declaration - repeal. (21) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, 7 will repeal on September 1, 2021: 8 The administration of the "Michael Skolnik Medical (VI)9 Transparency Act of 2010" by the director of the division of professions 10 and occupations in accordance with section 12-30-102; 11 (29) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled 12 for repeal on September 1, 2028: 13 (XIII) THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE "MICHAEL SKOLNIK MEDICAL TRANSPARENCY ACT OF 2010" by the director of the division of 14 15 PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 16 12-30-102. 17 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-30-102, amend 18 (12) as follows: 19 12-30-102. Medical transparency act of 2010 - disclosure of 20 information about health care providers - fines - rules - short title -21 legislative declaration - review of functions - repeal. (12) This section 22 is repealed, effective September 1, 2021 SEPTEMBER 1, 2028. Before the 23 repeal, the functions of the program under this section are scheduled for 24 review in accordance with section 24-34-104.

- SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect September 1,
   2021.
- 3 SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
  4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
  5 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
