

SENATE BILL 21-097

BY SENATOR(S) Garcia and Smallwood, Fields, Ginal, Jaquez Lewis; also REPRESENTATIVE(S) Caraveo and Williams, Bird, Hooton, Lontine, McCormick, Michaelson Jenet, Mullica, Ricks, Sandridge, Snyder, Weissman.

Concerning the continuation of the "Michael Skolnik Medical Transparency Act of 2010", and, in connection therewith, implementing the recommendation contained in the 2020 sunset report by the department of regulatory agencies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal** (21)(a)(VI); and **add** (29)(a)(XIII) as follows:

- 24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment legislative declaration repeal. (21) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, will repeal on September 1, 2021:
- (VI) The administration of the "Michael Skolnik Medical Transparency Act of 2010" by the director of the division of professions and

occupations in accordance with section 12-30-102;

- (29) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2028:
- (XIII) THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE "MICHAEL SKOLNIK MEDICAL TRANSPARENCY ACT OF 2010" BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 12-30-102.
- **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-30-102, **amend** (12) as follows:
- 12-30-102. Medical transparency act of 2010 disclosure of information about health care providers fines rules short title legislative declaration review of functions repeal. (12) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2021 SEPTEMBER 1, 2028. Before the repeal, the functions of the program under this section are scheduled for review in accordance with section 24-34-104.
- **SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act takes effect September 1, 2021.
