# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A PROVISIONAL PHYSICAL THERAPIST LICENSE.

# **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill allows the physical therapy board to issue a provisional license to applicants who have successfully completed a physical therapy program, met the educational requirements, and paid a fee. A person with a provisional license is required to practice under the supervision of a licensed physical therapist. The provisional license expires no later than 90 days after issuance.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 12-41-107.5 as
3	follows:
4	12-41-107.5. Provisional license - fee. (1) The BOARD MAY ISSUE
5	A PROVISIONAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE AS A PHYSICAL THERAPIST TO A
6	PERSON WHO:
7	(a) SUBMITS AN APPLICATION AND PAYS A FEE AS DETERMINED BY
8	THE DIRECTOR; AND
9	(b) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES A PHYSICAL THERAPY PROGRAM
10	THAT MEETS THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS IN SECTION $12-41-107(1)$
11	(a).
12	(2) A PERSON WHO HOLDS A PROVISIONAL LICENSE MAY ONLY
13	PRACTICE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A PHYSICAL THERAPIST LICENSED
14	PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-41-107.
15	(3) A PROVISIONAL LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION
16	EXPIRES NO LATER THAN NINETY DAYS AFTER THE DATE IT WAS ISSUED.
17	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
18	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
19	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
20	6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a
21	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
22	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
23	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
24	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

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- 1 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
