4	23-1-108.5. Duties and powers of the commission with regard
5	to common course numbering system - definitions. (3) (e) This
6	subsection (3) is repealed, effective September 1, 2021. Prior to such
7	repeal, the council of higher education representatives shall be reviewed
8	as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
9	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
10	(12)(a)(V) as follows:
11	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
12	declaration - definition - repeal. (12) (a) The following statutory
13	authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on
14	September 1, 2021:
15	(V) The council of higher education representatives convened
16	pursuant to section 23-1-108.5 (3), C.R.S.;
17	SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect September 1,
18	2021.
19	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
20	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
