A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION
102	DESIGNATION BENEFITING THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND TO
103	APPEAR ON THE STATE INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX RETURN <u>FORMS</u> ,
104	AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

For income tax years commencing on or after January 1, 2011, but before January 1, 2021, the bill requires a voluntary contribution

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designation line for the public education fund (fund) to appear as the first voluntary contribution designation line on state individual income tax return forms.

The department of revenue must determine annually the total amount designated to the fund and report that amount to the state treasurer and the general assembly. The state treasurer shall credit that amount to the fund.

Finally, the general assembly must appropriate annually from the fund to the department of revenue its costs of administering contributions to the fund. All moneys remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall be appropriated to the department of education and the department of higher education as specified.

8	39-22-3901. Legislative declaration. (1) THE GENERAL
9	ASSEMBLY HEREBY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT:
10	(a) OF ALL OF THE SERVICES PROVIDED BY STATE AND LOCAL
11	GOVERNMENTS, PUBLIC EDUCATION, <u>BEGINNING WITH PRESCHOOL</u>
12	EXERCISES THE MOST WIDESPREAD, DIRECT INFLUENCE ON THE CITIZENS
13	OF THE STATE, ENSURING THEM A WIDER RANGE OF OPPORTUNITIES AND A
14	GREATER LIKELIHOOD OF ECONOMIC SUCCESS;
15	(b) IN PROVIDING A WELL-EDUCATED CITIZENRY, A WELL-FUNDED,
16	EFFECTIVE PRESCHOOL AND PUBLIC EDUCATION SYSTEM ALSO INCREASES
17	THE LIKELIHOOD THAT THE STATE WILL ENJOY A STRONG ECONOMY THAT
18	ATTRACTS INVESTMENT BY BUSINESSES AND INDUSTRIES THAT FURTHER

(c) DURING PERIODS OF BUDGETARY REDUCTIONS, IT IS CRUCIAL
 THAT THE STATE MAINTAINS FUNDING FOR <u>PRESCHOOL</u> TO THE GREATEST
 EXTENT POSSIBLE.

4 (2) IN ORDER TO ASSIST IN FUNDING <u>PRESCHOOL</u>, THE GENERAL 5 ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZES THAT MANY CITIZENS OF COLORADO MAY BE 6 WILLING TO PROVIDE MONEYS TO AID THE PRESCHOOL AND PUBLIC 7 EDUCATION SYSTEM IN ITS EFFORTS. IT IS THEREFORE THE INTENT OF THE 8 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PROVIDE COLORADANS WITH THE OPPORTUNITY 9 TO SUPPORT PRESCHOOL AND PUBLIC EDUCATION BY ALLOWING CITIZENS 10 TO MAKE A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION ON THEIR STATE INCOME TAX 11 RETURN FORM TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND FOR SUCH A PURPOSE.

12 **39-22-3902.** Voluntary contribution designation - procedure. 13 FOR THE FIVE CONSECUTIVE INCOME TAX YEARS IMMEDIATELY 14 FOLLOWING THE YEAR IN WHICH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FILES WRITTEN 15 CERTIFICATION WITH THE REVISOR OF STATUTES AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 16 39-22-1001 (8), AS ENACTED BY HOUSE BILL 11-1097, ENACTED IN 2011, 17 THAT A LINE HAS BECOME AVAILABLE AND THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND 18 VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION IS NEXT IN THE QUEUE, THE COLORADO STATE 19 INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX RETURN FORM SHALL CONTAIN A LINE WHEREBY 20 EACH INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER MAY DESIGNATE THE AMOUNT OF THE 21 CONTRIBUTION, IF ANY, THE INDIVIDUAL WISHES TO MAKE TO THE PUBLIC 22 EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 39-22-3903 (1).

39-22-3903. Contributions credited to the public education
fund - creation - appropriation. (1) The department of Revenue
shall determine annually the total amount designated
pursuant to section 39-22-3902 and shall report that amount to
the state treasurer and to the general assembly. The state

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TREASURER SHALL CREDIT THAT AMOUNT TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION
 FUND, WHICH FUND IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY. ALL
 INTEREST DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF MONEYS IN
 THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

5 (2) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY 6 FROM THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE ITS 7 COSTS OF ADMINISTERING MONEYS DESIGNATED AS CONTRIBUTIONS TO 8 THE FUND. 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14 39-22-3904. **Repeal of part.** This part 39 is repealed, 15 EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1 OF THE SIXTH INCOME TAX YEAR FOLLOWING THE 16 YEAR IN WHICH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FILES WRITTEN CERTIFICATION 17 WITH THE REVISOR OF STATUTES AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 39-22-1001 (8), 18 AS ENACTED BY HOUSE BILL 11-1097, ENACTED IN 2011, THAT A LINE HAS 19 BECOME AVAILABLE AND THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND VOLUNTARY 20 CONTRIBUTION IS NEXT IN THE QUEUE, UNLESS THE VOLUNTARY 21 CONTRIBUTION TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND ESTABLISHED BY THIS 22 PART 39 IS CONTINUED OR REESTABLISHED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 23 ACTING BY BILL PRIOR TO SAID DATE.

5	(2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
6	appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
7	budgeting, for allocation to the office of information technology, for the
8	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the sum of twenty-nine thousand
9	six hundred dollars (\$29,600), or so much thereof as may be necessary,
10	for the provision of programming services to the department of revenue
11	related to the implementation of this act. Said sum shall be from
12	reappropriated funds received from the department of revenue out of the
13	appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.
14	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
15	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
