**PREVENTION, EARLY DETECTION, AND TREATMENT PROGRAM BY
TWO MILLION DOLLARS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Joint Budget Committee. The bill eliminates the annual transfer of \$2,000,000 from the prevention, early detection, and treatment fund (fund), which receives 16% of the revenues collected from amendment 35 tobacco and cigarette taxes, to the department of health care policy and financing for medicaid disease management and treatment programs that address cancer, heart disease, and lung disease or risk factors associated with those diseases. As a result, the amount of money annually appropriated from the fund to the prevention services division of the department of public health and environment for the cancer, cardiovascular disease, and chronic pulmonary disease prevention, early detection, and treatment program increases by \$2,000,000.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-22-117, **amend**
3 (2) (d) (V) (A); and **repeal** (2) (d) (IV.5) as follows:

12 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2014.

13 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
