### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS
AFTER A DECLARED DISASTER EMERGENCY.

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. In the event of a declared disaster emergency, the bill authorizes the governor to determine the percentage at which the state and a local government will contribute moneys to cover the nonfederal cost share required by federal law when the disaster emergency triggers federal assistance to the local government through the federal emergency management agency. As soon as practicable after making such a determination, the governor is required to notify the joint budget committee of the source and amount of state moneys that will be contributed to cover the nonfederal cost share.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-704, add (7) 3 (i) as follows: 4 The governor and disaster emergencies -24-33.5-704. 5 governor's disaster emergency council - creation - expert emergency **epidemic response committee - creation.** (7) In addition to any other 6 7 powers conferred upon the governor by law, the governor may: 8 (j) DETERMINE THE PERCENTAGE AT WHICH THE STATE AND A 9 LOCAL GOVERNMENT WILL CONTRIBUTE MONEYS TO COVER THE 10 NONFEDERAL COST SHARE REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL "ROBERT T. 11 STAFFORD DISASTER RELIEF AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE ACT", AS 12 AMENDED, 42 U.S.C. SEC. 5121 ET SEQ. AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER 13 MAKING SUCH A DETERMINATION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL NOTIFY THE 14 JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE OF THE SOURCE AND AMOUNT OF STATE 15 MONEYS THAT WILL BE CONTRIBUTED TO COVER A NONFEDERAL COST 16 SHARE PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH (i). SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1107, add 17 18 (1) (d) as follows: 19 **24-33.5-1107.** Community loans. (1) Whenever, at the request 20 of the governor, the president of the United States has declared a major 21 disaster to exist in this state, the governor is authorized: 22 (d) TO DETERMINE THE PERCENTAGE AT WHICH THE STATE AND A 23 LOCAL GOVERNMENT WILL CONTRIBUTE MONEYS TO COVER THE
