A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING POLICIES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF CODES OF 102 BEHAVIOR AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires all higher education institutions that receive money from the college opportunity fund (institutions) to adopt policies on sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, and hate crimes involving a student, faculty, or staff member consistent with the provisions of the bill. The bill requires the policy to be published in handbooks and on the institution's website. Institutions are required to

14	(2) On or before August 1, 2018, the governing board of

16	SEXUAL ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, STALKING,
17	AND HATE CRIMES. THE POLICY MUST INCLUDE:
18	(a) DEFINITIONS OF PROHIBITED BEHAVIOR;
19	(b) THE PROTOCOL FOR REPORTING AND RESPONDING TO REPORTS
20	OF SEXUAL ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, STALKING,
21	OR HATE CRIMES BY OR ON A STUDENT OR FACULTY OR STAFF MEMBER.
22	THE PROTOCOL MUST INCLUDE:
23	(I) THE RIGHTS OF VICTIMS AND PERSONS REPORTING SEXUAL
24	ASSAULTS, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, STALKING, OR HATE
25	CRIMES; AND

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1	(II) THE RIGHTS OF PERSONS ACCUSED OF A SEXUAL ASSAULT,
2	DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, STALKING, OR A HATE CRIME;

4	(c) SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATIONS. THE SANCTIONS MUST INCLUDE
5	MAKING A NOTATION ON THE TRANSCRIPT OF A STUDENT WHO IS FOUND
6	RESPONSIBLE FOR A SEXUAL ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING
7	VIOLENCE, STALKING, OR A HATE CRIME THROUGH A CONDUCT PROCESS
8	THAT THE STUDENT WAS SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED AFTER A FINDING OF A
9	VIOLATION OF THE POLICY. THE POLICY MUST ALSO ESTABLISH A PROCESS
10	FOR REQUESTING THE REMOVAL OF THE NOTATION AND THE APPEAL OF A
11	DENIAL OF THE REMOVAL.
12	(2) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL MAKE THE
13	INSTITUTION'S POLICY AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF
14	MEMBERS BY:
15	(a) INCLUDING THE POLICY IN THE INSTITUTION'S STUDENT
16	HANDBOOK AND PERSONNEL HANDBOOK; AND
17	(b) CREATING AND MAINTAINING A PAGE ON THE INSTITUTION'S
18	WEBSITE DEDICATED SOLELY TO THE POLICY.
19	(4) On or before August 1, 2020, and on or before August
20	1 EVERY TWO YEARS THEREAFTER, EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
21	EDUCATION SHALL REVIEW THE INSTITUTION'S POLICY AND, WITH
22	APPROVAL OF THE INSTITUTION'S GOVERNING BOARD, REVISE THE POLICY
23	AS NECESSARY.
24	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
25	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
26	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
2.7	9 2017 if adjournment sine die is on May 10 2017); except that if a

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- referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
- state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
- 3 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
- 4 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
- November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 6 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
