SENATE BILL 20-134

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN LANGUAGE USED TO DETERMINE CASH
FUND REVENUE THAT IS DERIVED FROM NON-FEE SOURCES WHEN
CALCULATING THE AMOUNT OF UNCOMMITTED RESERVES IN A CASH
FUND AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-402, **amend**
(2)(h)(IV) as follows:

**24-75-402. Cash funds - limit on uncommitted reserves -
reduction in the amount of fees - exclusions - repeal.** (2) For purposes
of this section, unless the context otherwise requires:

(h) "Uncommitted reserves" means the fund balance of a cash fund
as of June 30 of any fiscal year, minus the following:

(IV) Any portion of the revenues credited to the cash fund that is

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
