Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The Colorado health service corps advisory council reviews applications and makes recommendations for participation in the Colorado health service corps program (program). The program awards educational loan repayment for medical professionals who agree to provide primary health services in federally designated health professional shortage areas in Colorado.

The bill continues the Colorado health service corps advisory council indefinitely.

Colorado health service corps advisory council -5 creation - membership - duties. (6) (a) This section is repealed, 6 effective July 1, 2017. 7 (b) Prior to said repeal, the advisory council shall be reviewed as 8 provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S. 9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 10 (4)(a)(VI) as follows: 11 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 12 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (4) (a) The following statutory 13 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July 14 1, 2017: (VI) The Colorado health service corps advisory council created 15 16 in section 25-1.5-504, C.R.S.; 17 **SECTION 3.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 19 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
