A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPROPRIATION OF MONEY FROM THE SEVERANCE TAX OPERATIONAL FUND TO THE WILDFIRE MITIGATION CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT FUND, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill authorizes the general assembly to appropriate up to \$10 million from the severance tax operational fund (operational fund) to the wildfire mitigation capacity

SENATE Amended 2nd Reading February 8, 2023 development fund (wildfire fund) for fiscal year 2022-23 and makes a corresponding appropriation. The bill authorizes the general assembly to appropriate up to \$5 million from the operational fund to the wildfire fund beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 and in each fiscal year thereafter. Such appropriations may be made only if less than 100% of the money available in the operational fund is used for current core programs.

In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-29-109.3, amend 3 (1)(g)(II); and add (1)(g)(IV) and (1)(g)(V) as follows: 4 39-29-109.3. Severance tax operational fund - core reserve -5 grant program reserve - definitions - repeal. (1) The executive director 6 of the department of natural resources shall submit with the department's 7 budget request for each fiscal year a list and description of the programs 8 the executive director recommends to be funded from the severance tax 9 operational fund created in section 39-29-109 (2)(b), referred to in this section as the "operational fund". 10	treasury. The fund consists of money transferred to the fund pursuant to

15	SECTION 3. Appropriation. For the 2022-23 state fiscal year,
16	\$10,000,000 is appropriated to the wildfire mitigation capacity

18	appropriation is from the severance tax operational fund created in
19	section 39-29-109 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. The department of natural resources
20	is responsible for the accounting related to this appropriation.
21	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
