# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN HOSPITALS FROM THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE INFORMATION CONCERNING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under current law, certain hospitals are required to make information available to patients concerning the hospital's financial assistance, charity care, and payment plans, as well as offer to screen each uninsured patient for financial assistance. The bill amends the definition of "hospital" and exempts psychiatric hospitals, rehabilitation hospitals, and long-term acute care hospitals from the provisions of the law.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-3-112, **amend** (6) 3 as follows: 4 25-3-112. Hospitals - charges for the uninsured - collections 5 protection - charity care information. (6) For the purposes of this 6 section, "hospital" means a GENERAL hospital licensed pursuant to THIS 7 part 1 of article 3 of this title or certified pursuant to section 25-1.5-103 8 (1) (a) (II) THAT IS REQUIRED TO HAVE AN EMERGENCY ROOM AND THAT 9 PROVIDES ACUTE CARE SERVICES. A"GENERAL HOSPITAL" DOES NOT MEAN 10 A PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITAL, REHABILITATION HOSPITAL, OR LONG-TERM 11 ACUTE CARE HOSPITAL. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS AN 12 EXEMPTED HOSPITAL FROM COMPLYING WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS 13 SECTION. 14 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
