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SECTION 4. Appropriation to the department of human
 services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014. In Session Laws of
 Colorado 2014, amend section 2 of chapter 298, (HB 14-1338), as
 follows:

5 Section 2. Appropriation. In addition to any other appropriation, 6 there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund not 7 otherwise appropriated, to the department of human services, for the 8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$250,000, or so much 9 thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the special purpose 10 subdivision of the executive director's office for expenses related to the 11 regional center task force and utilization study. OF THE MONEYS 12 APPROPRIATED IN THIS SECTION, \$75,000 SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO THE 13 DEPARTMENT UNTIL JUNE 30, 2016.

SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
