A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE EXAMINING BOARD OF
102 PLUMBERS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN
103 APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee. The bill continues the examining board of plumbers and the statutory article governing the regulation of plumbers until September 1,

The standards of the international plumbing code are made the minimum standards for plumbing in the state. The board is further directed to adopt a fuel gas code for the inspection of gas piping installations.

The board is given authority to conduct inspections in local jurisdictions. The board may make a finding that a local jurisdiction has failed to meet the minimum requirements of state law.

The bill repeals existing provisions requiring dual certification of fire sprinkler inspectors and allowing plumbing work to continue if an inspection is not completed within 5 days.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **amend** (44) introductory portion; **repeal** (44) (d); and **add** (55) as follows:

24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.

(44) The following agencies, functions, or both, ~~shall~~ terminate on July 1, 2013:

(d) ~~The examining board of plumbers, created by article 58 of title 12, C.R.S.;~~

(55) THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES, FUNCTIONS, OR BOTH, TERMINATE ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2024:

(a) THE STATE PLUMBING BOARD, CREATED BY ARTICLE 58 OF TITLE 12, C.R.S.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-102, **amend** (1), (4), and (5) (a) introductory portion; repeal (5) (a) (I) and (5) (a) (II); and add (4.1) as follows:

12-58-102. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the context otherwise requires:

(1) "Board" means the examining board of plumbers STATE

3 (4) "Colorado plumbing code" OR "THE CODE" means a code
4 established by the board that consists of standards for plumbing
5 installation, plumbing materials, conservation, medical gas, sanitary
6 drainage systems, and solar plumbing that could directly affect the
7 potable water supply.

8 (4.1) "COLORADO FUEL GAS CODE" MEANS A CODE ADOPTED BY
9 RULE BY THE BOARD FOR THE INSPECTION OF PLUMBING FUEL GAS PIPE
10 INSTALLATIONS.

11 (5)(a) "Plumbing" includes the following items located within the
12 building or extending five feet from the building foundation, excluding
13 any service line extending from the first joint to the property line: All
14 potable water supply and distribution pipes and piping; all plumbing
15 fixtures and traps; all drainage and vent pipes; ALL WATER CONDITIONING
16 APPLIANCES CONNECTED TO THE POTABLE WATER SYSTEM; all building
17 drains, including their respective joints and connections, devices,
18 receptacles, and appurtenances; all multipurpose residential fire sprinkler
19 systems in one- and two-family dwellings and townhouses that are part
20 of the potable water supply; and all medical gas and vacuum systems in
21 health care facilities. "Plumbing" does not include:

22 (I) The installation, extension, alteration, or maintenance,
23 including the related water piping and the indirect waste piping
24 therefrom, of domestic appliances equipped with backflow preventers,
25 including lawn sprinkling systems, residential ice makers, humidifiers,
26 electrostatic filter washers, water heating appliances, water conditioning
27 appliances not directly connected to the sanitary sewer system, building

1 heating appliances and systems, fire protection systems except for
2 multipurpose residential fire sprinkler systems in one- and two-family
3 dwelling and townhouses that are part of the potable water supply, air
4 conditioning installations, process and industrial equipment and piping
5 systems, or indirect drainage systems not a part of a sanitary sewer
6 system; or

7 (II) The repair and replacement of garbage disposal units and
8 dishwashers directly connected to the sanitary sewer system, including the
9 necessary replacement of all tail pipes and traps, or the repair,
10 maintenance, and replacement of sinks, faucets, drains, showers, tubs, and
11 toilets.

12 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-103, **amend**
13 (1), (3) (a), and (5) as follows:

14 **12-58-103. Examining board of plumbers - repeal of article.**

15 (1) There is hereby established within the division of professions and
16 occupations of the department of regulatory agencies the examining board
17 of plumbers. STATE PLUMBING BOARD. The board shall exercise its powers
18 and perform its duties and functions in the department of regulatory
19 agencies as if it were transferred to the department by a **type 1** transfer,
20 as such transfer is defined in the "Administrative Organization Act of
21 1968", article 1 of title 24, C.R.S.

22 (3) (a) The governor, with power of removal, shall appoint the
23 members of the board, subject to confirmation by the senate. except that
24 the five members serving on June 30, 1982, shall continue to serve until
25 the expiration of their respective terms of office. The governor shall
26 appoint one additional member to serve until July 1, 1983, and another
27 additional member to serve until July 1, 1986. Thereafter, members shall

1 be BOARD MEMBERS ARE appointed for four-year terms. Any vacancy
2 occurring in the membership of the board shall be filled by the governor
3 by appointment for the unexpired term of such member.

4 (5) This article is repealed, effective July 1, 2013 SEPTEMBER 1,
5 2024. Prior to such repeal, the examining board of plumbers STATE
6 PLUMBING BOARD shall be reviewed as provided for in section 24-34-104,
7 C.R.S.

8 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-104, **amend**
9 (1) (e) and (1) (f); **repeal** (1) (k); and **add** (1) (l), (1) (m), and (1) (n) as
10 follows:

11 **12-58-104. Powers of board - fees - rules.** (1) In addition to all
12 other powers and duties conferred or imposed upon the board by this
13 article, the board is authorized and empowered to:

14 (e) In accordance with ~~the provisions of~~ article 4 of title 24,
15 C.R.S., prescribe, enforce, amend, and repeal rules ~~and regulations~~
16 governing the plumbing drainage, sewerage, and plumbing ventilation
17 SYSTEMS of all buildings in this state. == == ==

18 (f) Employ PLUMBERS LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE AS
19 JOURNEYMAN OR MASTER PLUMBERS AS STATE PLUMBING inspectors and
20 charge fees for making inspections of plumbing work covered by the
21 Colorado plumbing code in those areas where the local jurisdiction ~~has~~
22 ~~not adopted its own plumbing code and where that jurisdiction has~~
23 ~~requested such inspections~~ DOES NOT CONDUCT INSPECTIONS AND ISSUE
24 PERMITS;

25 (k) ~~Establish minimum requirements and standards for the~~
26 ~~inspection of multipurpose residential fire sprinkler systems in one- and~~
27 ~~two-family dwellings and townhouses that are part of the potable water~~

1 supply, by requiring inspectors of multipurpose residential fire sprinkler
2 systems in one- and two-family dwellings and townhouses to be certified
3 by the division of fire prevention and control in the department of public
4 safety pursuant to section 24-33.5-1206.4, C.R.S.

5 (l) FIND, UPON HOLDING A HEARING, THAT AN INCORPORATED
6 TOWN OR CITY, COUNTY, OR CITY AND COUNTY FAILS TO MEET THE
7 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTICLE IF THE LOCAL INSPECTION
8 AUTHORITY HAS FAILED TO ADHERE TO THE MINIMUM STANDARDS
9 REQUIRED BY THIS ARTICLE WITHIN TWELVE MONTHS AFTER THE BOARD
10 HAS ADOPTED THE STANDARDS BY RULE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION
11 (1);

12 (m) ISSUE AN ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM ISSUING PERMITS
13 OR PERFORMING INSPECTIONS UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO AN INCORPORATED
14 TOWN OR CITY, COUNTY, OR CITY AND COUNTY UPON FINDING THAT THE
15 PUBLIC ENTITY FAILS TO MEET THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
16 ARTICLE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (1);

17 (n) APPLY TO A COURT TO ENJOIN AN INCORPORATED TOWN OR
18 CITY, COUNTY, OR CITY AND COUNTY FROM VIOLATING AN ORDER ISSUED
19 PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (m) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1).

20 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-104.5, **amend**
21 (1) and (2); and **add** (5) as follows:

22 **12-58-104.5. Colorado plumbing code - amendments -**
23 **variances** - **Colorado fuel gas code.** (1) In accordance with ~~the~~
24 ~~provisions of~~ article 4 of title 24, C.R.S., the board shall establish a
25 Colorado plumbing code, as defined in section 12-58-102 (4). Such code
26 shall represent the minimum standards for installation, alteration, and
27 repair of plumbing equipment and systems throughout the state.

1 (2) Local governments ~~shall be~~ ARE permitted to amend the code
2 ~~when adopting a plumbing code~~ for their jurisdictions as long as such
3 amendments are at least equal to the minimum requirements set forth in
4 the Colorado plumbing code.

5 (5) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT A COLORADO FUEL GAS CODE FOR
6 THE GAS PIPING INSTALLATIONS INSPECTION REQUIREMENT OF SECTION
7 12-58-104 (1) (j).

8 **SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-107, amend**
9 **(1) (a) as follows:**

10 **12-58-107. License issuance - examination.** (1) (a) The board
11 shall issue licenses to persons who have by examination and experience
12 shown themselves competent and qualified to engage in the business,
13 trade, or calling of a residential plumber, journeyman plumber, or master
14 plumber. The board shall establish the minimum level of experience
15 required for an applicant to receive a residential, journeyman, or master
16 plumber's license. The maximum experience the board may require for an
17 applicant to qualify to receive TEST FOR a residential plumber's license is
18 two years or three thousand four hundred hours of practical experience.
19 The maximum experience the board may require for an applicant to
20 qualify to receive TEST FOR a journeyman plumber's license is four years
21 or six thousand eight hundred hours of practical experience. An applicant
22 for a master plumber's license shall furnish evidence that he has five years
23 of practical experience. THE MAXIMUM EXPERIENCE THE BOARD MAY
24 REQUIRE FOR AN APPLICANT TO TEST FOR A MASTER PLUMBER'S LICENSE
25 IS EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED HOURS OF PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE.

26 **SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal and reenact,**
27 **with amendments, 12-58-107.5 as follows:**

1 **12-58-107.5. Credit for experience received outside of**
2 **Colorado.** FOR ALL APPLICANTS SEEKING WORK EXPERIENCE CREDIT
3 TOWARD LICENSURE FOR PLUMBING WORK EXPERIENCE RECEIVED OUTSIDE
4 OF COLORADO, THE BOARD SHALL GIVE CREDIT FOR SUCH WORK
5 EXPERIENCE IF THE APPLICANT CAN SHOW TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE
6 BOARD THAT THE PARTICULAR EXPERIENCE IS ADEQUATE TO COMPLY WITH
7 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTICLE.

8 **SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend 12-58-108** as
9 follows:

10 **12-58-108. License renewal - reinstatement.** (1) All license
11 AND CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION renewal and renewal fees shall be in
12 accordance with the provisions of sections 24-34-102 and 24-34-105,
13 C.R.S.

14 (2) Any license OR CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION that has lapsed
15 shall be deemed to have expired. Prior to reinstatement, the board is
16 authorized to require the licensee to demonstrate competency. Licenses
17 shall be renewed or reinstated pursuant to a schedule established by the
18 director of the division of professions and occupations within the
19 department of regulatory agencies and pursuant to section 24-34-102 (8),
20 C.R.S. The director of the division of professions and occupations within
21 the department of regulatory agencies may establish renewal fees and
22 delinquency fees for reinstatement pursuant to section 24-34-105, C.R.S.
23 If a person fails to renew his or her license pursuant to the schedule
24 established by the director of the division of professions and occupations,
25 such license OR CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION shall expire. Any person
26 whose license OR CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION has expired shall be subject
27 to the penalties provided in this article or section 24-34-102 (8), C.R.S.

1 **SECTION 9.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-110, **amend**

2 (1) (p) as follows:

3 **12-58-110. Disciplinary action by board - licenses or**
4 **registrations denied, suspended, or revoked - cease-and-desist orders.**

5 (1) The board may deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew any license
6 or registration issued or applied for under the provisions of this article or
7 place a licensee or a registrant on probation for any of the following
8 reasons:

9 (p) Selling or fraudulently obtaining or furnishing a license OR
10 REGISTRATION to practice as a residential, journeyman, or master plumber
11 OR PLUMBING CONTRACTOR or aiding or abetting in such activity;

12 **SECTION 10.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-113, **add** (6)
13 as follows:

14 **12-58-113. Exemptions.** (6) (a) **NOTHING IN THIS ARTICLE**
15 **REQUIRES A PLUMBING LICENSE, CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION, OR PERMIT**
16 **TO PERFORM:**

17 (I) **THE INSTALLATION, EXTENSION, ALTERATION, OR**
18 **MAINTENANCE, INCLUDING THE RELATED WATER PIPING AND THE INDIRECT**
19 **WASTE PIPING, OF DOMESTIC APPLIANCES EQUIPPED WITH BACKFLOW**
20 **PREVENTERS, INCLUDING LAWN SPRINKLING SYSTEMS; RESIDENTIAL ICE**
21 **MAKERS, HUMIDIFIERS, ELECTROSTATIC FILTER WASHERS, OR WATER**
22 **HEATING APPLIANCES; BUILDING HEATING APPLIANCES AND SYSTEMS; FIRE**
23 **PROTECTION SYSTEMS EXCEPT FOR MULTIPURPOSE RESIDENTIAL FIRE**
24 **SPRINKLER SYSTEMS IN ONE- AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS AND**
25 **TOWNHOUSES THAT ARE PART OF THE POTABLE WATER SUPPLY; AIR**
26 **CONDITIONING INSTALLATIONS; PROCESS AND INDUSTRIAL EQUIPMENT**
27 **AND PIPING SYSTEMS; OR INDIRECT DRAINAGE SYSTEMS NOT A PART OF A**

1 SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM; OR
2 (II) THE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF GARBAGE DISPOSAL UNITS
3 AND DISHWASHERS DIRECTLY CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER
4 SYSTEM, INCLUDING THE NECESSARY REPLACEMENT OF ALL TAIL PIPES
5 AND TRAPS, OR THE REPAIR, MAINTENANCE, AND REPLACEMENT OF SINKS,
6 FAUCETS, DRAINS, SHOWERS, TUBS, AND TOILETS.

7 (b) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (6),
8 "PLUMBING" DOES NOT INCLUDE:

9 (I) INSTALLATIONS, EXTENSIONS, IMPROVEMENTS, REMODELING,
10 ADDITIONS, AND ALTERATIONS IN WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS OWNED OR
11 ACQUIRED BY COUNTIES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 20 OF TITLE 30, C.R.S.,
12 CITIES AND TOWNS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 35 OF TITLE 31, C.R.S., OR
13 WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICTS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 1 OR ARTICLE
14 4 OF TITLE 32, C.R.S.;

15 (II) INSTALLATIONS, EXTENSIONS, IMPROVEMENTS, REMODELING,
16 ADDITIONS, AND ALTERATIONS PERFORMED BY CONTRACTORS EMPLOYED
17 BY COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS, OR WATER AND SEWER DISTRICTS THAT
18 CONNECT TO THE PLUMBING SYSTEM WITHIN A PROPERTY LINE; OR

19 (III) PERFORMANCE, LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION,
20 INSTALLATION, AND USE OF ON-SITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS
21 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 10 OF TITLE 25, C.R.S., WHICH ARE LOCATED
22 WITHIN A PROPERTY LINE.

23 **SECTION 11.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-114.2,
24 **amend** (1); and **add** (3) as follows:

25 **12-58-114.2. Plumbing inspectors - qualifications.** (1) The
26 director of the division of professions and occupations is authorized to
27 appoint or employ competent persons LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE AS

1 JOURNEYMAN OR MASTER PLUMBERS as state plumbing inspectors.

2 (3) (a) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, PERSONS LICENSED UNDER THIS
3 ARTICLE OR WHO ARE CERTIFIED AS A RESIDENTIAL PLUMBING INSPECTOR
4 BY A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED MODEL CODE ORGANIZATION ARE
5 AUTHORIZED TO INSPECT RESIDENTIAL PLUMBING. ANY NEWLY HIRED
6 INSPECTORS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR CERTIFIED BY A
7 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED MODEL CODE ORGANIZATION HAVE ONE YEAR
8 FROM THE DATE OF HIRE TO ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY LICENSE OR
9 CERTIFICATION OR MEET THE HIRING REQUIREMENTS OF THE HIRING
10 AUTHORITY, WHICHEVER IS MORE STRINGENT.

11 (b) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, PERSONS LICENSED UNDER THIS
12 ARTICLE OR WHO ARE CERTIFIED AS A COMMERCIAL PLUMBING INSPECTOR
13 BY A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED MODEL CODE ORGANIZATION ARE
14 AUTHORIZED TO INSPECT COMMERCIAL PLUMBING. ANY NEWLY HIRED
15 INSPECTORS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR CERTIFIED BY A
16 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED MODEL CODE ORGANIZATION HAVE ONE YEAR
17 FROM THE DATE OF HIRE TO ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY LICENSE OR
18 CERTIFICATION OR MEET THE HIRING REQUIREMENTS OF THE HIRING
19 AUTHORITY, WHICHEVER IS MORE STRINGENT.

20 **SECTION 12.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-117, amend
21 (1) as follows:

22 **12-58-117. Apprentices.** (1) Any person may work as a
23 plumbing apprentice for a licensed plumber REGISTERED PLUMBING
24 CONTRACTOR but shall not do any plumbing work for which a license is
25 required pursuant to this article except under the supervision of a licensed
26 plumber. Supervision requires that ~~the~~ A licensed plumber supervise
27 apprentices at the jobsite. One licensed journeyman plumber, master

1 plumber, or residential plumber shall not supervise more than three
2 apprentice plumbers at the same jobsite.

3 **SECTION 13.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-114.5,
4 **amend** (1) and (3) (a) introductory portion; and add (8) as follows:

5 **12-58-114.5. Inspection - application - standards.** (1) Any
6 plumbing or gas piping installation in any new construction or remodeling
7 or repair, other than manufactured units inspected in accordance with the
8 provisions of part 7 of article 32 of title 24, C.R.S., except in any
9 incorporated town or city, any county, or any city and county ~~having its~~
10 ~~own plumbing code equal to the minimum standards provided in this~~
11 ~~article, shall~~ THAT CONDUCTS INSPECTIONS AND ISSUES PERMITS, MUST be
12 inspected by a state plumbing ~~inspector in those areas where a local~~
13 ~~jurisdiction has requested such inspections~~ INSPECTOR. A state plumbing
14 inspector shall inspect any new construction, remodeling, or repair subject
15 to the provisions of this subsection (1) within three working days after the
16 receipt of the application for inspection. ~~If the inspection is not performed~~
17 ~~within five working days, work may resume on any such construction,~~
18 ~~repair, or remodeling.~~ Prior to the commencement of any such plumbing
19 or gas piping installation, the person making such installation shall ~~make~~
20 ~~application~~ APPLY for ~~inspection~~ A PERMIT and pay the required fee.
21 ~~therefor.~~ Every mobile home or movable structure owner shall have the
22 plumbing and gas piping hookup for such mobile home or movable
23 structure inspected prior to obtaining new or different plumbing or gas
24 service.

25 (3) (a) All inspection permits issued by the board shall be ARE
26 valid for a period of twelve months, and the board shall cancel the permit
27 and remove it from its files at the end of the twelve-month period.

1 MONTHS. THE BOARD SHALL CLOSE A PERMIT AND MARK ITS STATUS AS
2 "EXPIRED" AT THE END OF THE TWELVE-MONTH RENEWAL PERIOD, except
3 in the following circumstances:

4 (8) IF AN INCORPORATED TOWN OR CITY, COUNTY, OR CITY AND
5 COUNTY INTENDS TO COMMENCE OR CEASE PERFORMING PLUMBING
6 INSPECTIONS IN ITS JURISDICTION, IT SHALL COMMENCE OR CEASE THE
7 SAME ONLY AS OF JULY 1 OF ANY YEAR, AND WRITTEN NOTICE OF SUCH
8 INTENT MUST BE GIVEN TO THE BOARD ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF THE
9 PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR. IF SUCH NOTICE IS NOT GIVEN AND THE USE
10 OF STATE PLUMBING INSPECTORS IS REQUIRED WITHIN THE JURISDICTION
11 AFFECTED BY THE NOTICE REQUIREMENT, THE RESPECTIVE LOCAL
12 GOVERNMENT OF THE JURISDICTION REQUIRING SUCH INSPECTIONS SHALL
13 REIMBURSE THE BOARD FOR ANY EXPENSES INCURRED IN PERFORMING
14 SUCH INSPECTIONS, IN ADDITION TO TRANSMITTING THE REQUIRED PERMIT
15 FEES.

16 **SECTION 14.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-115, **amend**
17 (1) as follows:

18 **12-58-115. Municipal and county regulations.** (1) Any city,
19 town, county, or city and county of this state may provide for the
20 licensing of plumbing contractors. PLUMBING CONTRACTORS WHO OBTAIN
21 LOCAL LICENSING MUST ALSO REGISTER WITH THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE
22 WITH SECTION 12-58-105 (3).

23 **SECTION 15. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
24 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
25 division of professions and occupations cash fund created in section
26 24-34-105 (2) (b) (I), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise
27 appropriated, to the department of regulatory agencies, for the fiscal year

1 beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$259,175 and 3.6 FTE, or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, to be allocated for the implementation of this
3 act as follows:

4 (a) \$190,338 and 3.6 FTE to the division of professions and
5 occupations for personal services;

6 (b) \$7,848 to the division of professions and occupations for
7 operating expenses and capital outlay;

8 (c) \$55,195 to the executive director's office and administrative
9 services and to the division of professions and occupations for travel
10 expenses including vehicle lease payments, expenses, and mileage; and

11 (d) \$5,794 to the executive director's office and administrative
12 services for the purchase of legal services.

13 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
14 appropriated to the department of law, for the fiscal year beginning July
15 1, 2013, the sum of \$5,794, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for
16 the provision of legal services for the department of regulatory agencies
17 related to the implementation of this act. Said sum is from reappropriated
18 funds received from the department of regulatory agencies out of the
19 appropriation made in paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of this section.

20 **SECTION 16. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
21 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
