A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE COORDINATION OF VARIOUS ECONOMIC
102	DEVELOPMENT REPORTS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH,
103	REQUIRING THE COLORADO OFFICE OF ECONOMIC
104	DEVELOPMENT TO REPORT ANNUALLY TO THE GENERAL
105	ASSEMBLY REGARDING THE PROGRAMS IT ADMINISTERS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Section 1 of the bill requires the Colorado office of economic

development (office) to submit a report annually to the general assembly describing the office's programs. The annual report must be made on or before November 1, and the duty to make the annual report continues indefinitely.

For reports currently required from the office or the economic development commission, **sections 2 to 5** of the bill make November 1 the date by which the reports must be submitted.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-48.5-101, add (7) 3 as follows: 4 Colorado office of economic development -24-48.5-101. 5 creation - duties - report. (7) (a) ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1, 2012, 6 AND, NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 24-1-136 (11), ON OR BEFORE 7 NOVEMBER 1 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF 8 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, SHALL SUBMIT 9 A REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE A 10 REVIEW AND SUMMARY OF THE ACTIVITY, INFORMATION, AND DATA ON 11 ALL THE PROGRAMS THAT THE OFFICE ADMINISTERED DURING THE PRIOR 12 FISCAL YEAR, AND SHALL INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM: 13 (I) THE REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRESS REPORTS 14 RECEIVED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-48.7-104(4), AS ENACTED BY HOUSE 15 BILL 12-1154; 16 (II) THE BUSINESS RETENTION AND EXPANSION PROGRAM REPORT 17 REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-48.5-114 (5), AS ENACTED BY 18 SENATE BILL 12-005; AND 19 (III) THE KEY INDUSTRIES STRATEGY AND KEY INDUSTRY BUSINESS 20 PLANS REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-48.5-114 (6), AS 21 ENACTED BY SENATE BILL 12-144. 22 (b) IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PREPARING THE REPORT REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION
 (7), THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IS AUTHORIZED TO
 INCORPORATE OR APPEND TO SUCH REPORT ANY OTHER REPORTS IT IS
 REQUIRED BY LAW TO DEVELOP.

5 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-46-104, amend
6 (2) as follows:

7 24-46-104. Powers and duties of commission. (2) The
8 commission shall report to the general assembly no later than February
9 NOVEMBER 1 of each year regarding the work of the commission. The
10 report shall include but shall not be limited to, the information required
11 to be collected by the commission pursuant to section 24-46-105.1.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-46-308, amend
(5) as follows:

14 **24-46-308.** Annual report - audit. (5) The Colorado office of 15 economic development and the department of revenue shall prepare a 16 report to be submitted by the office no later than September NOVEMBER 17 1 of the applicable fiscal year to the finance committees of the house of 18 representatives and senate, the business affairs and labor AND ECONOMIC 19 DEVELOPMENT committee of the house of representatives, and the 20 business, labor, and technology committee of the senate, or any successor 21 committees. The report shall present information on all tax expenditures 22 for regional tourism economic development during the prior fiscal year 23 and shall include information from the reports required pursuant to 24 subsection (6) of this section.

25 SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-48.5-108, amend
26 (4) (b) as follows:

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24-48.5-108. Bioscience research - evaluation - grants - fund

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1 - definitions - repeal. (4) Policies - reporting. (b) On or before April 2 15, 2008, and on or before April 15 NOVEMBER 1 OF each year, thereafter, 3 the director OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE shall submit a report to the 4 finance committees of the senate and house of representatives, or any 5 successor committees, summarizing the use of all moneys that were 6 awarded as grants from the program in the preceding calendar FISCAL 7 year. At a minimum, the report shall specify, with regard to the grant 8 recipients that received funding under the program during the preceding 9 calendar FISCAL year, the amount of grant moneys distributed to each 10 grant recipient and a description of each grant recipient's use of the grant 11 moneys.

SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-30-103, amend
(4) (b.7) as follows:

14 **39-30-103.** Zones established - termination. (4) (b.7) The 15 director of the Colorado office of economic development, OR THE 16 DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, on behalf of the Colorado economic development 17 commission, shall submit an annual report to the general assembly ON OR 18 BEFORE NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR summarizing the annual 19 documentation submitted by zone administrators to the director of the 20 Colorado office of economic development each year pursuant to 21 paragraphs (b) and (b.5) of this subsection (4). The director of the 22 Colorado office of economic development, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, 23 on behalf of the commission, shall make an annual presentation to the 24 legislative audit committee that reviews and summarizes the information 25 in the report submitted to the general assembly pursuant to this paragraph 26 (b.7).

27 **SECTION 6.** Act subject to petition - effective date. (1) Except

1 as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this act takes effect at 12:01 2 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after 3 final adjournment of the general assembly (August 8, 2012, if 4 adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a referendum 5 petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state 6 constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within 7 such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless 8 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 9 2012 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official 10 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

(2) (a) Section 24-48.5-101 (7) (a) (I), Colorado Revised Statutes,
as enacted in section 1 of this act, takes effect only if House Bill 12-1154
becomes law and takes effect on the applicable effective date of this act
or House Bill 12-1154, whichever is later.

(b) Section 24-48.5-101 (7) (a) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes, as
enacted in section 1 of this act, takes effect only if Senate Bill 12-005
becomes law and takes effect on the applicable effective date of this act
or Senate Bill 12-005, whichever is later.

(c) Section 24-48.5-101 (7) (a) (III), Colorado Revised Statutes,
as enacted in section 1 of this act, takes effect only if Senate Bill 12-144
becomes law and takes effect on the applicable effective date of this act
or Senate Bill 12-144, whichever is later.
