Bill Summary

For the 2009-10 and 2010-11 state fiscal years, the bill authorizes

SENATE Am ended 2nd Reading April8,2010 the amount of increased federal financial participation, pursuant to the federal "American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009" or other federal act, generated from appropriations out of the hospital provider fee cash fund to be used to offset other general fund appropriations for medicaid services. The bill recognizes that moneys in the health care expansion fund have been used to offset general fund expenditures for medicaid services. The bill specifies that the first \$41.4 million of increased federal financial participation shall be transferred to the health care expansion fund and that any amount in excess of \$41.4 million be appropriated for medicaid services.

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1	SECTION 3. Appropriation - adjustments to the 2010 long bill.
2	For the implementation of this act, appropriations made in the annual
3	general appropriation act to the department of health care policy and
4	financing, for medical services premiums, for the fiscal year beginning
5	July 1, 2010, shall be adjusted as follows:
6	(1) The general fund appropriation is decreased by forty-six
7	million three hundred twenty-nine thousand three hundred eighty-eight
8	dollars (\$46,329,388).
9	(2) The cash fund appropriation is increased by forty-six million
10	three hundred twenty-nine thousand three hundred eighty-eight dollars
11	(\$46,329,388). Said sum shall be from the hospital provider fee cash
12	fund created in section 25.5-4-402.3 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes.
13	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
14	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
15	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
