A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF INDICATING AN ASSESSMENT SCORE
102 ON A STUDENT'S HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT UNLESS THE
103 STUDENT AUTHORIZES THE ASSESSMENT SCORE TO BE
104 INDICATED ON THE STUDENT'S HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT.

Bill Summary

The bill prohibits a student's assessment score from being indicated on the student's high school transcript unless the student chooses to indicate an assessment score on the transcript.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-7-1016, **amend**
3 (2) as follows:

4 **22-7-1016. Assessments in high school - transcripts -**
5 **definition.** (2) (a) Each high school student's final transcript ~~shall~~ **MUST**
6 describe the student's level of postsecondary and workforce readiness by
7 ~~(a)~~ indicating the student's level of performance in the
8 postsecondary and workforce readiness program. ~~and~~

9 (b) (I) ~~Indicating~~ NOTWITHSTANDING ANY GRADUATION
10 REQUIREMENT ADOPTED BY A LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER, EACH HIGH
11 SCHOOL STUDENT'S TRANSCRIPT MUST NOT INDICATE the student's level of
12 performance on ~~the~~ A readiness ~~assessments~~ ASSESSMENT administered to
13 the student pursuant to section 22-7-1006.3 in high school OR ON A
14 NATIONAL ASSESSMENT UNLESS THE STUDENT AUTHORIZES THE
15 INDICATION OF AN ASSESSMENT ON THE STUDENT'S TRANSCRIPT.

16 (II) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (2)(b), "NATIONAL
17 ASSESSMENT" MEANS ANY ASSESSMENT THAT IS ADMINISTERED
18 THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES TO MEASURE POSTSECONDARY OR
19 WORKFORCE READINESS.

20 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
21 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
