A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CREATION OF THE POSITION OF LEGISLATIVE STATISTICIAN TO SUPPORT LEGISLATIVE ANALYSIS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

The bill requires the state auditor (auditor) to provide a brief description of the statistical methodology planned for each performance audit conducted or caused to be conducted by the auditor.

For each performance audit conducted or caused to be conducted by the auditor, the bill requires the person employed by the general assembly as a legislative statistician to, as appropriate:

- ! State whether the statistical methodology identified for use in connection with a particular audit was appropriate for the purposes for which it was applied;
- ! Verify whether reasonable efforts were undertaken to apply the appropriate statistical methodology for the particular audit as identified in the audit plan;
- Provide an explanation, if known to the statistician, of any deviations from the appropriate statistical methodology as identified in the audit plan; and
- ! Certify that the audit was conducted according to the statistical methodology for the particular audit as identified in the audit plan.

When the legislative statistician supports a performance audit, he or she shall be subject to all other requirements binding upon any member of the staff of the office of the state auditor governing the preparation or release of the findings of such audits, including any requirements pertaining to the confidentiality of such audits.

Subject to the conditions specified in the bill, for the 2011-12 state fiscal year, the bill transfers the equivalent of one full-time employee from the office of the state auditor to the staff of the legislative council for the purpose of employing a legislative statistician with professional expertise in statistical analysis. Thereafter, the legislative statistician shall be employed on the staff of the legislative council. The bill requires the legislative statistician to offer his or her training and expertise for the benefit of all of the legislative service agencies for the state fiscal year during which the position is fully funded and for subsequent state fiscal years.

The bill specifies that its requirements shall only be implemented if the executive committee elects, in its sole discretion, to make moneys available to fund the position of legislative statistician.
