A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING REMOVING THE PROHIBITION ON SELLING CONSUMABLE

102 PRODUCTS IN A RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under current law, a retail marijuana store is prohibited from selling any consumable product other a retail marijuana product. The bill removes that prohibition.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-402, amend
2	(7)(a) as follows:
3	12-43.4-402. Retail marijuana store license - definitions.
4	(7) (a) A licensed retail marijuana store may only sell retail marijuana,
5	retail marijuana products, marijuana accessories, CONSUMABLE
6	PRODUCTS, nonconsumable products such as apparel, and
7	marijuana-related products such as childproof packaging containers. but
8	shall be prohibited from selling or giving away any consumable product,
9	including but not limited to cigarettes or alcohol, or edible product that
10	does not contain marijuana, including but not limited to sodas, candies,
11	or baked goods.
12	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
13	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
14	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
15	8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
16	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
17	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
18	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
19	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
20	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
21	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
