(5) Healthcare affordability and sustainability fee 8 **cash fund.** (b) All money in the fund is subject to federal matching as 9 authorized under federal law and is continuously appropriated to AND, 10 SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SHALL 11 BE EXPENDED BY the enterprise for the following purposes: 12 **SECTION 2.** Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2018. 13 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
