CONCERNING THE TRANSFER TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE BALANCES FROM REPEALED CASH FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Repealed cash funds - transfer. (1) On July 1, 2021, the state treasurer shall transfer to the general fund the unexpended and unencumbered money that was in the economic gardening pilot project fund at the time section 24-48.5-102.7, C.R.S., was repealed and any interest and income since earned on the money.

(2) On July 1, 2021, the state treasurer shall transfer to the general fund the unexpended and unencumbered money that was in the public school energy efficiency fund at the time section 39-29-109.5, C.R.S., was repealed and any interest and income since earned on the money.
