A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF MONEYS FROM CERTAIN CASH FUNDS

TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer the balance of moneys remaining in the following cash funds as of June 30, 2011, to the state education fund:

- ! The national academic contest fund;
- ! The financial literacy cash fund;

- ! The reading assistance grant program fund.

The fund shall consist of such moneys as may be appropriated thereto by the general assembly and such moneys as may be credited thereto pursuant to section 22-7-704 (4). Moneys in the fund shall be subject to annual appropriation by the general assembly for the purposes specified in this part 7. The department may expend up to three percent of the moneys annually appropriated to the fund to offset the documented costs incurred in implementing the grant program. All interest derived from the deposit and investment of moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, at the end of any fiscal year, all unexpended and unencumbered moneys in the fund shall remain therein and shall not be credited or transferred to the general fund or any
