A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE MINIMUM AGE OF MOTORBOAT OPERATORS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

Current law prohibits the operation of a motorboat by a person who is less than 16 years of age; except that, a person who is at least 14 years of age but less than 16 years of age may operate a motorboat if the person has completed a boating safety course approved by the division of parks and wildlife and possesses a boating safety certificate issued by the boating safety course provider.

The bill raises the minimum age requirement from 16 to 18 years of age and retains the existing exceptions for certain persons who are at

fourteen years of age or older who has not reached his or her sixteenth birthday AND LESS THAN EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE may be permitted or authorized to operate a motorboat if he or she THE PERSON has met the boating safety and certificate requirements of subsection (2) of this section.

SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
