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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING A TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO
102	THE ENERGY FUND TO FINANCE THE WEATHERIZATION
103	ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OF THE COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill directs the state treasurer to make an immediate, one-time transfer of \$3 million from the general fund to the energy fund administered by the Colorado energy office (CEO). The CEO may use the money for making grants for the weatherization assistance program. The bill requires the CEO to periodically report on its expenditures to the





office of state planning and budgeting and the general assembly.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-38.5-102.4, add 3 (3) as follows: 4 Energy fund - creation - use of fund -24-38.5-102.4. 5 definitions - repeal. (3) (a) ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION 6 (3), OR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE THEREAFTER, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL 7 TRANSFER THREE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE 8 ENERGY FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION. THE 9 COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE SHALL USE THE MONEY TRANSFERRED UNDER 10 THIS SUBSECTION (3)(a) IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH SUBSECTIONS 11 (2)(b) AND (2)(c) OF THIS SECTION TO PROVIDE GRANTS PRIOR TO JUNE 30, 12 2022, FOR THE WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. 13 (b) (I) BY SEPTEMBER 2, 2022, THE COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE 14 SHALL REPORT THE AMOUNTS OF ALL GRANTS AWARDED UNDER THIS 15 SUBSECTION (3) AND THE PURPOSES TO WHICH THE GRANT MONEY IS 16 **DEDICATED, AS FOLLOWS:** 17 (A) TO THE OFFICE OF STATE PLANNING AND BUDGETING, THE 18 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE, 19 AND THE SENATE TRANSPORTATION AND ENERGY COMMITTEE OR THE 20 SUCCESSORS TO THOSE ENTITIES; AND 21 (B) TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 24-1-136 (9). 23 (II) IN ADDITION TO MAKING THE REPORT SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION 24 (3)(b)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE SHALL 25 INCORPORATE THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN ITS ANNUAL

  - (c) This subsection (3) is repealed, effective July 1, 2024.
- 3 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
- 4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 5 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
