## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO
102	THE COLORADO WATER CONSERVATION BOARD CONSTRUCTION
103	FUND FOR WATERSHED PROTECTION PROGRAMS, AND, IN
104	CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <u>http://leg.colorado.gov</u>.)

The bill transfers \$15 million from the general fund to the Colorado water conservation board construction fund for use by the Colorado water conservation board (CWCB) to protect watersheds

against the impacts of wildfires through the existing watershed restoration grant program and for conducting a statewide watershed analysis to investigate the susceptibility of life, safety, infrastructure, and water supplies to wildfire impacts. The CWCB can use up to 5% of the money to administer the grant program and up to 10% to provide technical engineering services to grantees. The CWCB is directed to:

- Spend up to \$500,000 by December 31, 2022, to conduct the analysis; and
- Award at least \$10 million dollars in grants under the grant program by July 1, 2022, and award the remaining money, less the money the CWCB uses to administer the grant program and provide technical engineering services, in grants by December 31, 2022.

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-60-121, amend

repeal. (11) (a) On the effective date of this subsection (11), the state
treasurer shall transfer four million dollars from the general fund to the
Colorado water conservation board construction fund.

(b) (I) WITHIN THREE DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
SUBSECTION (11)(b), THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER FIFTEEN
MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE COLORADO WATER
CONSERVATION BOARD CONSTRUCTION FUND.

(II) (A) EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTIONS (11)(b)(III) AND
(11)(b)(IV) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL USE THE MONEY
TRANSFERRED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (11)(b) IN CONNECTION
WITH THE WATERSHED RESTORATION PROGRAM FOR WATERSHED
RESTORATION AND FLOOD MITIGATION GRANTS TO RESTORE, MITIGATE,

AND PROTECT STREAM CHANNELS AND RIPARIAN AREAS SUSCEPTIBLE TO
 FLOOD HAZARDS AND SEDIMENT EROSION AND DEPOSITION AFTER
 WILDFIRE, INCLUDING EXPENDITURES FOR THE REPAIR, REPLACEMENT,
 MODIFICATION, MAINTENANCE, OR INSTALLATION OF RELATED WATER AND
 DEBRIS-CONTROL STRUCTURES, WITH SPECIAL CONSIDERATION OF
 PROJECTS WITH FEDERAL AND LOCAL MATCHING REQUIREMENTS.

7 (B) THE BOARD SHALL AWARD AT LEAST TEN MILLION DOLLARS OF
8 THE MONEY TRANSFERRED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (11)(b) BY
9 JULY 1, 2022, AND SHALL AWARD THE REMAINING MONEY BY DECEMBER
10 31, 2022.

(III) THE BOARD SHALL EXPEND UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND
 DOLLARS BY DECEMBER 31, 2022, FOR A STATEWIDE WATERSHED
 ANALYSIS TO INVESTIGATE THE SUSCEPTIBILITY OF LIFE, SAFETY,
 INFRASTRUCTURE, AND WATER SUPPLIES TO WILDFIRE IMPACTS.

15 (IV) THE BOARD MAY USE UP TO FIVE PERCENT OF THE MONEY TO 16 ADMINISTER THE GRANT PROGRAM AS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (11)(b)(II) 17 OF THIS SECTION AND MAY USE UP TO TEN PERCENT FOR THE COSTS 18 ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING NECESSARY TECHNICAL ENGINEERING 19 SERVICES TO ASSIST GRANTEES WITH DESIGN REVIEW, ENGINEERING 20 ANALYSIS, FIRE AND FLOOD SUPPORT, CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT, FLUVIAL 21 HAZARD ZONE PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION, PROJECT MONITORING AND 22 ADAPTIVE MANAGEMENT, AND OVERALL PROGRAM MANAGEMENT.

(c) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL INCLUDE
UPDATES REGARDING THE BOARD'S ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN PURSUANT
TO SUBSECTION (11)(b) OF THIS SECTION IN ITS DEPARTMENTAL
PRESENTATION TO LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE PURSUANT TO
SECTION 2-7-203.

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- (d) THIS SUBSECTION (11) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1,
- 2 2026.

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SECTION 2. Appropriation. (1) For the 2020-21 state fiscal
year, \$15,000,000 is appropriated to the department of natural resources
for use by the Colorado water conservation board. This appropriation is
from the Colorado water conservation board construction fund created in
section 37-60-121, C.R.S. The Colorado water conservation board may
use this appropriation for the purposes specified in section 37-60-121
(11)(b), C.R.S.

(2) The money appropriated in subsection (1) of this section
 remains available for the designated purposes until it is fully expended.
 SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
