Bill Summary

The bill creates the Colorado firefighting air corps (C-FAC) under the division of fire prevention and control (division) in the department of public safety.

THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF PROVIDING AIRCRAFT FROM THE
 C-FAC THAT ARE REQUESTED THROUGH THE INTERAGENCY DISPATCH
 SYSTEM OR PURSUANT TO AN AGREEMENT DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH
 (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b). ALL REIMBURSEMENTS SHALL BE CREDITED TO
 THE COLORADO FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION
 (3) OF THIS SECTION.

7 (c) THE DIRECTOR MAY FULFILL ANY OF THE DUTIES CONTAINED IN

11 THE DIVISION SHALL ADMINISTER THE COLORADO (3) (a) 12 FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS FUND, WHICH FUND IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE 13 STATE TREASURY. THE DIVISION IS AUTHORIZED TO SEEK AND ACCEPT 14 GIFTS, GRANTS, REIMBURSEMENTS, OR DONATIONS FROM PRIVATE OR 15 PUBLIC SOURCES FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION. THE FUND CONSISTS 16 OF ALL MONEYS THAT MAY BE APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND BY THE 17 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC FUNDS RECEIVED 18 THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, REIMBURSEMENTS, OR DONATIONS THAT ARE 19 TRANSMITTED TO THE STATE TREASURER AND CREDITED TO THE FUND. 20 ALL INTEREST EARNED FROM THE INVESTMENT OF MONEYS IN THE FUND 21 ARE CREDITED TO THE FUND. THE MONEYS IN THE FUND ARE HEREBY 22 CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR THE PURPOSES INDICATED IN 23 PARAGRAPH (c) OF THIS SUBSECTION (3). ANY MONEYS NOT EXPENDED AT 24 THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR REMAIN IN THE FUND.

(b) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
THIS SECTION DOES NOT RELY ENTIRELY OR IN ANY PART ON THE RECEIPT
OF ADEQUATE FUNDING THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS.

THEREFORE, THE DIVISION IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS
 SPECIFIED IN SECTION 24-75-1303 (3).

3 (c) THE DIVISION SHALL USE THE MONEYS IN THE COLORADO
4 FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS FUND FOR THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF
5 MAINTAINING THE COLORADO FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS, INCLUDING
6 EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH ACQUISITION, RETROFITTING, LABOR,
7 EQUIPMENT, SUPPLY, TRANSPORTATION, AIR, MOBILIZATION, REPAIR,
8 MAINTENANCE, AND DEMOBILIZATION.

9 SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
