Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Joint Budget Committee. For the current state fiscal year and for the next 3 state fiscal years, the state treasurer is required to transfer money from the general fund to the capital construction fund and the highway users tax fund (Senate Bill 228 transfers). For the current fiscal year, the Senate Bill 228 transfers are fixed amounts and for the





remaining years, they are a percentage of the total general fund revenues, that may be reduced or eliminated if the state has to refund excess state revenues in accordance with the taxpayer's bill of rights.

The bill reduces the transfer to the highway users tax fund to be made for the current fiscal year on June 30, 2017, from \$158 million to \$79 million. The future conditional transfers to the highway users tax fund are replaced with the following fixed transfers:

\$79 million on June 30, 2018;

\$160 million on June 30, 2019; and

\$160 million on June 30, 2020.

The future conditional transfers to the capital construction fund are replaced with the following fixed transfers:

No transfer for the fiscal year 2017-18;

1 \$60 million on June 30, 2019; and

\$60 million on June 30, 2020.

The bill also repeals provisions that relate to the conditional transfers.

7 (I) One hundred fifty-eight SEVENTY-NINE million dollars from

9 (c) For each state fiscal year from state fiscal year 2017-18 10 through the state fiscal year 2019-20, the state treasurer shall transfer 11 from the general fund to the: ON JUNE 30, 2018, THE STATE TREASURER 12 SHALL TRANSFER SEVENTY-NINE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL 13 FUND TO THE HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND.

(I) Highway users tax fund, an amount equal to two percent of the

between the actual amounts required to be transferred to the funds and the
 estimated amounts previously transferred pursuant to subparagraph (I) of
 this paragraph (b).

4 (4) (a) For any state fiscal year for which there are excess state
5 revenues that are required to be refunded pursuant to section 20 of article
6 X of the state constitution, the quarterly and year-end amounts that are
7 required to be transferred to the funds pursuant to paragraph (b) of
8 subsection (3) of this section shall:

9 (I) Be reduced by fifty percent, if the amount of the refund is 10 greater than one percent of the general fund revenues for the state fiscal 11 year but less than or equal to three percent of the total general fund 12 revenues for the state fiscal year; and

(II) Not be made, if the amount of the refund is greater than three
 percent of the total general fund revenues for the state fiscal year.

(b) The calculations required pursuant to paragraph (a) of this
subsection (4) shall be based on the most recent revenue estimate
prepared by the legislative council staff that is available at the time of
each transfer; except that the last transfer made for each state fiscal year
shall be based on the actual revenues for the state fiscal year.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
