Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-219, **add** (8) as follows:

24-75-219. Transfers - transportation - capital construction - definitions - repeal. (8) On July 1, 2021, the state treasurer shall transfer one hundred twenty-four million dollars from the general fund to the state highway fund.
