2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-30-2114, repeal
3	(4) (c) as follows:
4	24-30-2114. Surcharge - collection and distribution - address
5	confidentiality program surcharge fund - creation - definitions
6	(4) (c) No general fund moneys shall be appropriated for the purpose of
7	implementing the address confidentiality program.
8	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds
9	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
