the general assembly appropriated moneys for the Colorado state capitol dome restoration project. The capitol dome restoration project is now complete, and a portion of the moneys appropriated for the project are currently unexpended and unencumbered. To authorize the department of personnel and administration to use the unexpended and unencumbered moneys for the next planned phase of the state capitol restoration, the bill amends the general appropriation act for the 2013-14 fiscal year to allow the moneys originally appropriated for the Colorado state capitol dome restoration project to be used more generally for Colorado state capitol restoration.
