WHEREAS, Section 2-2-303.5 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes,
authorizes the General Assembly to designate the convening date for
regular sessions by joint resolution; now, therefore,

4 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-second General 5 Assembly of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives 6 concurring herein: HOUSE Final Reading May 2, 2019



That, pursuant to section 2-2-303.5 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes,
the General Assembly designates Wednesday, January 8, 2020, as the
convening date for the Second Regular Session of the Seventy-second
General Assembly.

- 5 *Be It Further Resolved*, That in the Joint Rules of the Senate and 6 House of Representatives, Rule No. 23, **amend** (a)(1), (a)(1.6), and (a)(2) 7 as follows:
