SENATE RESOLUTION 20-002

101 **CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF FEBRUARY 4 AS "MISSING**
102 **PERSONS DAY" IN COLORADO.**

1 WHEREAS, While too many families grieve and hope for their
2 missing children, others are in search of their missing family members of
3 all ages; and

4 WHEREAS, The awareness of citizens, media, and law
5 enforcement, as well as their support, their efforts, and their search for
6 missing persons, must continue; and

7 WHEREAS, The public plays a critical role in the success of the
8 AMBER Alert program and other alert programs: They become the eyes
9 and ears of law enforcement and can be on the lookout for the missing
10 person; and

11 WHEREAS, The common misconception that a person must be
12 absent for at least 24 hours before being legally classified as missing is
13 dangerous. When there is evidence of violence or of an unusual absence,
14 it is critical that an investigation begin promptly.

1 WHEREAS, New advances in technology must be utilized and
2 made available to locate the missing; and

3 WHEREAS, The state of Colorado is committed to the safety and
4 well-being of its citizens, both children and adults; and

5 WHEREAS, The designation of Missing Persons Day in Colorado
6 will firmly embed the importance of missing persons and their families
7 and friends in our state calendar and will raise a level of awareness with
8 other cities and states that have already designated a Missing Persons
9 Day; and

10 WHEREAS, The designation of Missing Persons Day in Colorado
11 offers a platform to plan events that will connect families with resources
12 to help identify and find their long-term missing loved ones; and

13 WHEREAS, Each year, hundreds of thousands of families are
14 faced with what President Ronald Reagan called "the stark terror of a
15 unique tragedy" -- a missing family member; and

16 WHEREAS, On January 10, 2020, the FBI reported 86,989 active
17 missing persons in the United States, with a large portion being juveniles
18 under the age of 21; and

19 WHEREAS, Children and adults go missing from their families for
20 a number of devastating reasons: They run away or wander and become
21 lost; they disappear under circumstances indicating that their
22 disappearance may not have been voluntary; or they go missing under
23 suspicious circumstances, indicating that they may be in physical danger
24 or the victims of foul play; and

25 WHEREAS, In 2002, Colorado Governor Bill Owens signed
26 House Bill 02-1083, establishing the AMBER (America's Missing:
27 Broadcast Emergency Response) Alert program in Colorado. Named after
28 nine-year-old Amber Hagerman, who was abducted and killed in Texas
29 in 1996, the program ensures that local law enforcement agencies can use
30 the Emergency Alert System in Colorado to broadcast information to alert
31 citizens of missing children.

32 WHEREAS, Since 1996, AMBER Alerts have successfully
33 recovered 977 children nationally and 61 due to the Wireless Emergency
34 Alert; and

1 WHEREAS, For all the important work done to recover missing
2 children, the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children assisted
3 law enforcement and families in 2019 with more than 29,000 cases of
4 missing children nationwide, and the organization lists 155 active missing
5 child cases in Colorado with posters circulating on nearly 70 of those
6 cases. Even though all disappeared from their families when they were
7 children, some have been missing for decades.

8 WHEREAS, The designation of Missing Persons Day in Colorado
9 will ensure that the families and friends of the missing know that they are
10 not alone in this tragedy of uncertainties and lack of closure, which leads
11 to extreme suffering and long-lasting effects on the health, finances, and
12 relationships of those left behind; and

13 WHEREAS, Every missing person is someone's son or daughter,
14 father or mother, brother or sister, partner or friend, and every missing
15 person deserves to be searched for and found; now, therefore,

16 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-second General*
17 *Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

18 (1) That we, the members of the Colorado Senate, recognize the
19 epidemic of the missing in America as "The Silent Mass Disaster" and
20 empathize with the ongoing suffering of the families and friends of those
21 who are missing;

22 (2) That we recognize the importance of raising awareness of the
23 number of people who go missing in Colorado each year;

24 (3) That we applaud the committed efforts of families, law
25 enforcement agencies, and concerned citizens who work to locate missing
26 persons;

27 (4) That we encourage the continued support of worthy initiatives
28 and private and public programs to increase efforts to locate missing
29 persons;

30 (5) That we hereby designate February 4 of each year as "Missing
31 Persons Day" and support the goals and ideals of the day; and

32 (6) That we acknowledge the names, and the families, of the
33 Coloradans who are currently missing: Christopher Enoch Abeyta, Victor
