"AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSIT-ORIENTED COMMUNITIES."

- Strike subsection (e) of section 2 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "(e) In determining whether a transit-oriented district is of reasonable 4 size, the secretary, or a consultant engaged by the secretary, in 5 consultation with the zoning commission of the municipality, shall (1) 6 determine whether the area of such district is adequate to support 7 greater density of development in an equitable manner, as determined 8 by the secretary, or a consultant engaged by the secretary, considering 9 the geographic characteristics of the municipality; (2) consider 10 municipal and regional housing needs; and (3) exclude the following 11 lands in any such district: (A) Special flood hazard areas designated on 12 a flood insurance rate map published by the National Flood Insurance

Program, (B) wetlands, as defined in section 22a-29 of the general

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14 statutes, (C) land designated for use as a public park, (D) land subject to 15 conservation or preservation restrictions, as defined in section 47-42a of 16 the general statutes, (E) coastal resources, as defined in section 22a-93 of 17 the general statutes, (F) areas necessary for the protection of drinking 18 water supplies, and (G) areas designated as likely to be inundated 19 during a thirty-year flood event by the Marine Sciences Division of The 20 University of Connecticut pursuant to the division's responsibilities to 21 conduct sea level change scenarios pursuant to subsection (b) of section 22 25-680 of the general statutes. If deemed necessary by the zoning 23 commission to determine whether a transit-oriented district is of 24 reasonable size, such commission shall consult with the inland wetlands 25 agency of the municipality and any other municipal agency deemed 26 necessary by such commission to determine whether such district is of 27 reasonable size."
