- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (Effective from passage) Not later than January 1, 2022, the
- 4 Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Public
- 5 Health, shall develop for use by a local or regional board of education
- 6 (1) a uniform policy concerning timely notification to the parents or
- 7 guardians of students in grades nine to twelve, inclusive, about the
- 8 Connecticut School Health Survey not later than twenty-one calendar
- 9 days prior to the date such board will be administering the survey at a
- 10 high school governed by such board, and (2) a form to be distributed to
- 11 parents or guardians for the purposes of the notification required
- 12 pursuant to subdivision (1) of this section that includes, but is not
- 13 limited to, (A) an explanation of the Connecticut School Health Survey

14 and how a parent or guardian may opt out of such survey being

administered to his or her child, and (B) the Internet link to the survey

16 that will be administered."
