"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and 2 internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective from passage) The Department of Public Health shall (1) compile a list of physicians, physician assistants and advanced practice registered nurses in the state who will accept and treat patients regardless of their vaccination status, and (2) provide such list, on or before October 1, 2021, to the parents or guardian of any child who (A) is enrolled in sixth grade or below at a public or nonpublic school in the state, (B) presented a statement, prior to the effective date of this section, from such parents or guardian that any immunization required pursuant to section 10-204a of the general statutes, as amended by this act, is contrary to the religious beliefs of such child or such parents or guardian, and (C) communicates in writing to such public or nonpublic school, on or before September 1, 2021, that they are seeking a written declaration from a physician, physician assistant or advanced
